
Aisha Jumaan — In base alla dichiarazione allegata del Ministero degli Esteri del Sultanato dell'Oman, sembra che il cessate il fuoco tra Stati Uniti e Ansar-Allah a Sana'a sia stato raggiunto di comune accordo. Ansar-Allah, in un'intervista rilasciata a DropSite da uno dei suoi leader, ha dichiarato: "Non ci consideriamo in guerra con il popolo americano", ha affermato Mohammed al-Bukhaiti, membro dell'ufficio politico di Ansar-Allah e portavoce di lunga data degli Houthi. "Se gli Stati Uniti smetteranno di colpire lo Yemen, cesseremo le nostre operazioni militari contro di esso".

Questa è stata una risposta alle dichiarazioni del Presidente Trump e del Segretario alla Difesa, secondo cui avrebbero smesso di bombardare lo Yemen se Ansar-Allah avesse accettato di smettere di attaccare le navi statunitensi. "La scelta per gli Houthi è chiara: smettete di sparare alle navi statunitensi e noi smetteremo di sparare a voi", ha scritto Trump in un post su TruthSocial il 31 marzo. Il Segretario alla Difesa Pete Hegseth ha dichiarato in un'intervista a Fox News: "Nel momento in cui gli Houthi diranno: 'Smetteremo di sparare alle vostre navi, smetteremo di sparare ai vostri droni', questa campagna finirà. Ma fino ad allora, sarà implacabile".

Sulla base di quanto riferito dallo Yemen, Ansar-Allah ha compreso che l'accordo non implica la cessazione dell'adesione di Israele.


In una recente dichiarazione, il presidente Trump ha affermato: "Ci fidiamo della loro parola... Li abbiamo colpiti duramente. Hanno avuto una grande capacità di resistere alle punizioni", ha affermato. "Si potrebbe dire che c'è molto coraggio in loro".

Un portavoce del Ministero degli Esteri ha dichiarato oggi che, a seguito dei recenti colloqui e contatti condotti dal Sultanato dell'Oman con gli Stati Uniti e le autorità competenti a Sana'a, nella Repubblica dello Yemen, con l'obiettivo di una de-escalation, gli sforzi hanno portato a un accordo di cessate il fuoco tra le due parti. In futuro, nessuna delle due parti prenderà di mira l'altra, comprese le navi americane, nel Mar Rosso e nello Stretto di Bab al-Mandab, garantendo la libertà di navigazione e il regolare flusso del traffico commerciale internazionale. Il Sultanato dell'Oman esprime la sua gratitudine a entrambe le parti per il loro approccio costruttivo che ha portato a questo risultato positivo e auspica che porti a ulteriori progressi su molte questioni regionali, verso il raggiungimento di giustizia, pace e prosperità per tutti.



Domanda 2 — Puoi approfondire la tua prima risposta: l'accordo tra Stati Uniti e Yemen prevede che alle navi da guerra statunitensi sarà consentito attraversare il Mar Rosso anche se Trump continua a fornire bombe e armi a Israele?

Aisha Jumaan — Non conosco i dettagli dell'accordo raggiunto tra Stati Uniti e Ansar-Allah. Tuttavia, in base a un articolo di Haaretz, molti dei trasferimenti di armi avvengono per via aerea. Inoltre, sembra che la maggior parte del carico marittimo di armi diretto a Israele passi attraverso il Mediterraneo, raggiungendo Haifa e Ashdod. Il porto di Eliat è stato dichiarato fallito a causa del blocco del Mar Rosso.



Un ritmo vertiginoso, poi un calo: come le spedizioni di armi statunitensi a Israele sono rallentate, Haaretz. I dati di tracciamento dei voli disponibili al pubblico mostrano quante spedizioni di armi statunitensi sono arrivate in Israele ogni mese dall'inizio della guerra di Gaza, rivelando un forte aumento e poi un graduale rallentamento del ritmo delle consegne.

Domanda 3— Il Pentagono ha dichiarato martedì che le forze del Comando Centrale degli Stati Uniti hanno colpito 1.000 obiettivi in Yemen dal 15 marzo, uccidendo circa 200 civili yemeniti e distruggendo gran parte delle infrastrutture critiche del Paese. **Quanto è grave la situazione sul campo per la gente comune?** (Cibo, acqua e forniture mediche sono sufficienti?)

Aisha Jumaan — Il numero di civili uccisi e feriti potrebbe essere molto più alto di quello riportato. È possibile che molti dei feriti siano morti a causa delle gravi ferite e della mancanza di cure mediche adeguate in Yemen. Il sistema sanitario yemenita è operativo solo al 50%, poiché la maggior parte dei centri sanitari è stata bombardata dalla coalizione guidata dall'Arabia Saudita.

Il secondo porto più grande per l'importazione di carburante e gas è stato distrutto dagli Stati Uniti, causando gravi carenze di carburante e benzina. Le persone aspettano in coda fino a 12 ore e ancora non riescono a fare rifornimento per le loro auto. Ecco cosa ha scritto una persona a Sana'a.

Questa persona dice che sono andato a fare la fila per fare rifornimento e quando sono uscito c'erano 45 macchine davanti a me.

Gli Stati Uniti e Israele hanno bombardato il porto di Hodeidah, rendendo difficile l'importazione di cibo, carburante e beni di prima necessità nel Paese. Circa 17 milioni di persone in Yemen necessitano di assistenza umanitaria. Milioni di bambini yemeniti soffrono di malnutrizione. Questo influirà sul loro sviluppo cognitivo e sulle loro generazioni future .



Aisha Jumaan — Direi che ci sono molteplici fattori che hanno spinto il popolo yemenita a schierarsi per Gaza, ben consapevole del prezzo che avrebbe pagato. Lo Yemen è stato oggetto di attacchi aerei quotidiani da parte della coalizione guidata dall'Arabia Saudita, sostenuta dagli Stati Uniti, per 8 anni. Lo Yemen è sotto embargo dal 2015 e gli yemeniti conoscono in prima persona le conseguenze di fame, malattie e collasso economico. È importante notare che, nonostante il blocco imposto dall'Arabia Saudita sullo Yemen dal 2015, lo Yemen non ha mai tentato di bloccare il Mar Rosso per cercare di revocarlo; lo ha fatto solo per Gaza. Alcuni dei fattori che hanno spinto gli yemeniti a schierarsi a favore di Gaza sono: Gli vemeniti sono fieramente indipendenti e non sopportano la colonizzazione. Lo Yemen è chiamato il cimitero degli invasori perché ha combattuto tutti coloro che hanno cercato di invaderlo, compresi i turchi. Aden era un protettorato dell'Impero inglese, ma per poter governare, gli inglesi dovettero modificare la demografia della città e importare non arabi. A un certo punto, la popolazione vemenita di Aden era solo il 20%. Lo Yemen è un paese antico, ricco di civiltà che hanno plasmato il popolo yemenita. Nel Corano, c'è un intero capitolo dedicato alla Regina di Saba, alla sua saggezza e alla forza del popolo yemenita. Gli yemeniti sono gentili e generosi e hanno imparato a difendere ciò che ritengono giusto. C'è un proverbio che dice: "Se non hai un amico, trovatene uno yemenita". It is important to understand that the Houthi movement against the established Yemeni government is essentially an internecine civil struggle that has been going on for over twenty years, now involving third parties with their own political-religious agendas. And it is clear that any third party involvement (Saudi, US, Iran, et al.) is unlikely to end the hostilities, as this latest US debacle has now demonstrated. In any case, results will not be happy for 'outsiders' who get involved.

China's position in the region, like all their foreign policy, is consistent. To avoid military conflict, but support diplomatic solutions. China has diplomatic relations with the Salem Saleh Salem bin Braik government, but not the Houthi faction. 
